Herbicide injury may be a consequence of an increase in these; be sure to check planting intervals on the herbicide label!

About 50% of the herbicide injury samples submitted to SDL in summer 2017 have been suspected cases of this

Herbicides may carryover in this material often used by gardeners

AMABDCI D I C A M B A

Active ingredient commonly used on lawns
